The Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) require MA-PD and PDP plans to maintain ongoing monitoring of their Medicare Part C and D programs. The new Part C and D Data Validation requirements are effective for CY2010. Plan sponsors need to begin the process of scoping the effort of selecting a Data Validation Contractor and assessing their Q1 2011 budgets when Data Validation reporting begins.
